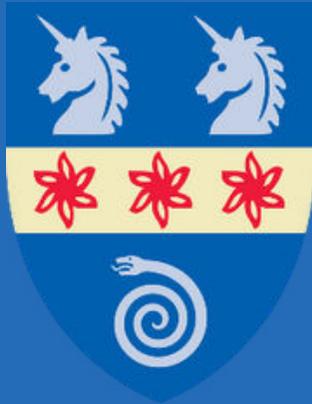


# St Hilda's College Graduate Accommodation

# 25 Alma Place OX4 1JW

6 bedrooms with a shared bathroom (including 1 shower and 2 toilets) and a small rear garden shared with 25a Alma.

Conveniently located a 5-minute walk from the college, just off Cowley Road, a thriving local scene providing access to local shops, bars, restaurants, and two supermarkets.

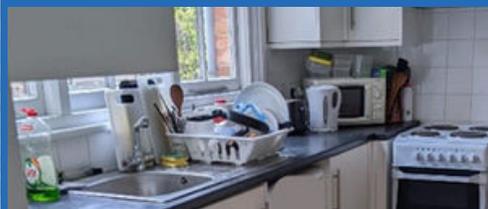


# 25a Alma Place OX4 1JW

# 19 Tyndale Road OX4 1JL

3 bedrooms, a shared bathroom (with 1 shower & 1 toilet), a separate dining area, and a small rear garden.

Conveniently located a 5-minute walk from the college, just off Cowley Road, a thriving local scene providing access to local shops, bars, restaurants, and two supermarkets.



# 89 Iffley Road OX4 1EG

4 bedrooms, shared bathrooms (with 2 showers & 2 toilets), a separate dining area, and a rear garden. All bedrooms feature small double beds, and the kitchens are equipped with induction hobs.

Situated a 10-minute walk from the college, just off Cowley Road, a thriving local scene offering access to shops, bars, restaurants, and two supermarkets.

Close to the University's Iffley Road Sports Centre, overlooking the tennis courts and running track.



# 39 St Margaret's Road OX2 6LD

4 ensuite double rooms  
3 standard double rooms  
5 standard small double and one small standard single room,  
2 kitchens,  
4 shared showers,  
4 shared toilets  
a large back garden

Close to Jericho, a lively local area by the canal with pubs, restaurants, bars. There is easy access to Oxford's incredible green space Port Meadow, where cattle and ponies have grazed for hundreds of years.



# 257 Iffley Road OX4 1SJ

2 standard rooms with small double beds  
4 ensuite rooms 2 with small double beds and 2 with single beds  
1 shared toilet and shower room

Located a 20 minute walk from college but just off Magdalen Road which has various a vibrant, community-focused street known for its thriving independent scene, packed with unique cafes, gastropubs, diverse eateries, boutiques, and essential local shops, offering a lively, "village feel", popular with those seeking artisanal food and local character.



# 11 Norham Gardens OX2 6PS

4 ensuite bedrooms and 39 standard bedrooms with a shared bathroom (multiple showers & toilets), along with a large kitchen, dining, lounge area, 2 small kitchens, a communal study space, and a spacious back garden. The bedrooms offer a mix of single and small double beds, while all kitchens are equipped with induction hobs.

Situated a 30-minute walk from the college, with local shops within a 10-minute walk and a 10-minute walk to town. It is close to University Parks and a short walk from Jericho a lively local area with pubs, restaurants, bars and cafes. It is also close to North Parade, a small and thriving shopping street, where a well-regarded local market takes place fortnightly.



# 14 Norham Gardens OX2 6PS

4 single ensuite bedrooms and 21 small double ensuite rooms, along with 9 double ensuite rooms equipped with kitchenettes. Additionally, there's a large kitchen, dining, lounge area and a spacious back garden.

Situated a 30-minute walk from the college, with local shops within a 10-minute walk and a 10-minute walk to town. It is close to University Parks and a short walk from Jericho a lively local area with pubs, restaurants, bars and cafes. It is also close to North Parade, a small and thriving shopping street, where a well-regarded local market takes place fortnightly.
