- Undertake skilled ornamental horticultural activities to ensure the gardens of the main site and the off-site properties are maintained to a high standard.
- Assist with project-planning, preparation and plant selection for developments within the gardens.
- Assist with monitoring and maintaining all College boundaries.
- Support the on-going sustainability programme and green initiatives of the College.
- Contribute to outreach and engagement events run by the Gardens Team.
- Deputise for the Head Gardener, as required.
- Operate all relevant machinery, equipment and tools and ensure such equipment is well-maintained and securely stored.
- Ensure health and safety standards are maintained at all times, reporting any concerns.
- Assist in College emergencies as and when required in a proactive and safe manner.
- Undertake continuous professional development.

In addition, you will be expected to perform any task reasonably assigned to you by your line manager.
